Design CD, Formats and Hoop Size

The Design CD contains the following:

- Flash presentation of the Designer
- Multi-Formatted designs
- Downloadable PDF showing Design name, size, stitch count, stitch sequence and recommended thread colors.
- Two downloadable PDFs of sewing projects
- Downloadable PDF of Expert Embroidery Tips
- Electric Quilt 6 files to allow you to design a quilt using the Designer's fabric and designs

The recommended thread colors on the Stitch Sequence PDF are for Coats & Clark Trilobal Polyester machine embroidery thread. In order for the thread colors to appear correctly in your machine, you must set the thread for Coats & Clark.

These designs are multi-format designs, digitized in the following formats:

- Bernina Artista (ART)
- POEM, Singer EU, Huskygram (CSD)
- Tajima (DST)
- Melco Expanded (EXP)
- Husqvarna Viking (HUS)
- Janome/New Home 10000 (JEF)

- Pfaff (PCS)
- Brother, Babylock, Bernina Deco, Simplicity, White (PES)
- Janome/New Home, Elna, Kenmore (SEW)
- Husqvarna Viking Designer I (SHV)
- Husqvarna Viking/Pfaff, VIP Customizing (VIP)
- Husqvarna Viking/Pfaff (VP3)
- Singer PSW, Compucon (XXX).

All these files may not work on every machine. Please check with your machine manufacturer for specific information related to design format and your machine's operational software.

Successful Embroidery

Always test sew your design prior to placing it on your real project. Make certain your fabric is hooped properly. Improper hooping can compromise the quality of your embroidery design. Hooping information can be found at <http://sewing.about.com/od/machineembroidery/ bb/embroidery.html> but please check with your local sewing machine dealer for information and instructions.

Check your hoop size. Some designs may be larger than your hoop which will require the design to be split and sewn in multiple hoopings. Check with your machine's manufacturer which may sell additional hoop sizes, design splitting software, continuous design software and other accessories to make your machine embroidery creativity easier and more fun.

Each collection has a downloadable PDF of the Design Stitch sequencing in recommended colors as well as the design name, design number, width and height of the design in inches and millimeters, and stitch count. Your embroidery machine's design format software may hold color information specific to the brand's thread preference or may only be programmed with basic thread colors. Thus, when you load the design into your machine the color names may not match those selected by our designers.

The Design Stitch sequencing PDF will help you know which thread to use for each color change. However, get creative and try new colors using these designs. That is the beauty of sewing and embroidering. You become the artist and a new color selection can change the whole look and feel of a design into something totally different.

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
